# UNDERGRADUATE DEGREES

Primarily three years in length (unless they include an additional work placement year) and enable specialisation from the start of study.

## COLOMBIA ENTRY REQUIREMENTS\*

One of the following:

- Bachiller Académico PLUS successful completion of a recognised International Foundation Programme - See those offered at INTO Queen's
- 3 UK A-Levels
- International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB)

## MEXICO ENTRY REQUIREMENTS\*

One of the following:

- Bachillerato (completed 12 years of education) with an average mark of 7/10 or 70% PLUS a recognised International Foundation Programme - See those offered at INTO Queen's
- Licenciado (successfully completed first year of a Mexican University degree) with good grades

in relevant subjects.

- International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB)

## INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE DIPLOMA\*

- Overall total score between 30 and 37 points\*\* PLUS
- Three subjects at Higher Level (with scores between 6,6,6 - 5,5,5)

## INTO QUEEN'S INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMMES

### International Foundation

Offering academic preparation and pathways into the first year of a wide range of undergraduate degrees at Queen's, subject to successful completion and meeting entry requirements. These programmes are available in:

- Architecture
- Business, Humanities and Social Sciences
- Engineering and Science

### International Year One

Leading to the International Diploma. This programme is equivalent to the first year of an UK undergraduate degree. Subject to reaching the required grades, students can transfer directly into the second year of a relevant undergraduate degree. Pathways available include:

- Accounting
- Engineering (Aerospace, Chemical, Civil, Electrical, Electronic, Mechanical and Manufacturing)
- Management and Finance

Enrolment for both INTO Queen's International Programmes is available in April, June, September and January leading to entry to a Queen's undergraduate degree the following September upon successful completion. They are taught over three, four or five terms with assessment throughout the year. Exams take place in the middle and final weeks.

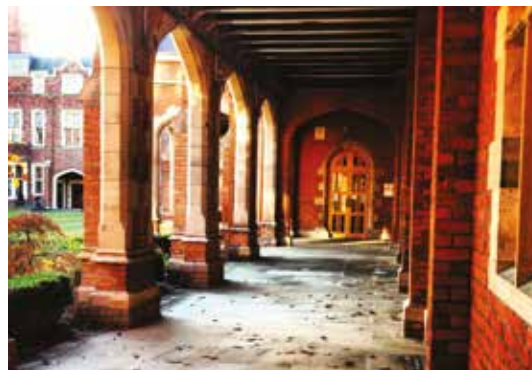
## HOW TO APPLY

Apply through [UCAS.com](http://UCAS.com) The UK's one stop shop for all undergraduate applications. For Queen's the institution code name is QBELF and the institution code is Q75. Deadline is 30 June (except Medicine and

Dentistry which is 15 October) although for equal consideration, it is recommended that applications should be submitted by 15 January. Or apply direct by downloading the application form at [go.qub.ac.uk/International-Applying](http://go.qub.ac.uk/International-Applying)

The QUB Direct Entry Application Form is also available for international applicants who only wish to apply to Queens and no other UK University.

Applicants for Medicine or Dentistry can only apply through UCAS.



## ENGLISH LANGUAGES REQUIREMENTS

If English is not your native language, you will need to demonstrate a minimum level of English. Queen's University requires the equivalent of 6.5 IELTS or TOEFL iBT 90. Minimum scores will be required in each component of the test and some degrees may have higher requirements. # POSTGRADUATE DEGREES

(Master's and PhDs)

Taught masters are generally one year in length with most including a combination of coursework and research. PhDs are research intensive and usually three to four years in length.

## USA ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- **Master's Degree**  
- A good four year Bachelor's degree with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.2 (2.8 GPA may be considered depending on programme). The major subject or content of your Bachelor's degree may also be considered.
- **MPhil/PhD** - A good four year Bachelor's degree and, normally a good Master's degree in addition to a strong research proposal.

## CANADA ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- **Master's Degree** - Four year Bachelor's degree with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4 point scale, 6.0 on a 9 point scale, 8.0 on a 12 point scale or 73% (where the pass mark is 50%). (2.8 GPA on a 4 point scale, 5.0 on a 9 point scale, 7.0 on a 12

point scale or 70% where pass mark is 50% may be considered depending on programme). The major subject or content of your Bachelor's degree may also be considered.

- **MPhil/PhD** - a good Four Year Bachelor's degree and, normally a good Master's degree in addition to a strong research proposal.

## QUB INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

Queen's offers over £1.5m (US \$2,129,757/ CAN \$2,618,719) scholarships to International Students towards tuition fees.

These range between **£2,000** (US \$2,839/CAN \$3,492) and **£3,000** (US \$4,259/CAN \$5,237) off first year tuition fees, depending on programme of study. The Queen's loyalty scholarship also offers 20% reduction off first year fees for those students returning to study full-time degree programmes.

Applicants are automatically assessed following receipt of an offer.

The Vice Chancellor's International Attainment Award also offers 5 full fee scholarships for the length of study.
